Reset The Records: Everyone's 0-0

All nine Big West schools are back on equal footing entering week one of conference play, each with the opportunity to navigate the 16-game schedule and emerge as regular season champion. The league slate tips off on Wednesday, with three games – Cal Poly at UC Santa Barbara, CSUN at UC Riverside, and Cal State Fullerton at Hawai'i.

Opening Statements

Cal State Fullerton has won three consecutive Big West openers overall. The Titans also have won their last three conference road opening games, and they will have a chance to make it four in Honolulu on Wednesday. Hawai'i has won three straight league home openers, so something will have to give. UC Riverside and UC Santa Barbara have the longest current losing streaks in Big West openers – three apiece. Here are the current streaks of the other five programs at the starting point of Big West play – Cal Poly (W1), CSUN (L1), Long Beach State (W1), UC Davis (W2) and UC Irvine (L1). Notably, the Beach have won their conference home debut in four straight seasons and host UC Davis on Saturday.

Gauchos Post 11 Wins In Non-League Play

UCSB registered its second consecutive 11-3 non-conference record under second-year head coach Joe Pasternack entering league play. Last season, the Gauchos lost to Cal Poly in their conference opener on the road. This time around, UCSB hosts the Mustangs with an opportunity to go 12-3 for the first time since the 2007-08 campaign.

Road Success Fuels UC Irvine's 12-4 Start

UCI finished non-conference play at 12-4. The 12 non-conference wins ties the school record initially set in 1981-82. The Anteaters posted a 5-2 road record, including wins at Texas A&M and Saint Mary's.

'Bows Off To Great Start

Hawai'i was the third Big West squad to conclude non-conference play with an above .500 record, the third time in four seasons the 'Bows have done so under Eran Ganot. UH claimed three prominent wins, beating a pair of Pac-12 squads (Utah and Colorado) as well as Rhode Island from the Atlantic 10 Conference.

Diane In Exclusive Club

CSUN freshman Lamine Diane – the Big West's leading scorer (24.3 ppg) and rebounder (11.1 rpg) – is one of just three players nationally to rank top 25 in both categories. The other two are South Dakota State senior Mike Daum and BYU junior Yoeli Childs.

PRIOR TO TIPOFF

CAL POLY AT UC SANTA BARBARA (BIGWEST.TV) - UC Santa Barbara has won nine of the last 10 meetings dating back to the 2014-15 season. Cal Poly's one victory during that stretch occurred in last season's conference opener in San Luis Obispo. The site shifts this year to the Thunderdome, where the Gauchos are 7-0 this season and 19-2 overall since Joe Pasternack took over the head coaching reins. UCSB is the top defensive club in the Big West, allowing 64.3 points per game. Cal Poly senior Donovan Fields is just 42 points shy of the career 1,000-point mark.

CSUN AT UC RIVERSIDE (WatchESPN) - This is the first of a minimum 20 games on the Big West's digital platform with ESPN3. The game pits CSUN's Mark Gottfried and UC Riverside's David Patrick in a meeting between two head coaches in year one leading their respective programs. The Matadors have been involved in eight games decided by five points or less, going 3-5 overall. The losses include New Mexico (87-84), Portland (80-77), Pacific (79-77), San Diego State (65-60) and Yale (94-90 in OT). CSUN has two of the top three Big West scorers in Lamine Diane and Terrell Gomez. UCR counters with junior Dikymbe Martin, fifth in scoring at 15.9 points per game. **PXP: Trent Rush • COLOR: Richie Schueler • SIDELINE: Courtney Sweet**

CAL STATE FULLERTON AT HAWAII - Hawai'i returns from a 10-day break well rested and hopes for more success in the Stan Sheriff Center, where the team is 8-2 this season. The Titans are 0-7 in road games, but played a brutal non-conference schedule that took them to places such as Arizona State, Saint Mary's, San Francisco, Nebraska and Washington. UH ranks No. 2 in the Big West in three-point made field goals (8.6 pg) and is 5-0 when hitting 10 or more.

Earning his first career Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week award, junior Jackson Rowe contributed a double-double in nearly leading Cal State Fullerton to a road upset of Washington.

- Rowe tallied 22 points and 11 rebounds for his second double-double this season – and the 11th of his career.

- The 22 points was a season-high for the 6-foot-7 forward in the narrow 84-76 loss against the Huskies.

BIG WEST COACHING

Long Beach State's **DAN MONSON** is the dean of Big West head coaches, entering his 12th season roaming the sidelines of the Walter Pyramid. He ranks eighth all-time in conference history with 191 wins, while his 114 Big West victories is sixth all-time. Only five Big West head coaches have accumulated 200 or more wins during their tenure with the conference – Bob Thomason (Pacific, 436), Jerry Tarkanian (Long Beach State & UNLV, 405), Bob Williams (UC Santa Barbara, 313), Neil McCarthy (New Mexico State, 248) and Jerry Pimm (UC Santa Barbara, 222). Monson has won a minimum of 15 games in each of the last 10 seasons, needing that total to get to 200 for his career during the 2018-19 campaign. Monson needs four wins to catch Fresno State's Boyd Grant (194) and seven to surpass UC Irvine's Pat Douglass (197) in the Big West record book.

GOTTFRIED, PATRICK NEWEST ADDITIONS TO BIG WEST COACHING FAMILY

Two new faces will be roaming the sidelines for the Big West this season. Veteran head coach **MARK GOTTFRIED** begins his first season at CSUN after three previous head coaching stints at Murray State (1995-98), Alabama (1998-09) and NC State (2011-17). Gottfried has compiled a Division I record of 407-251 during his 20-plus years of head coaching experience. He has reached the NCAA Tournament 11 times, including an Elite Eight appearance with Alabama in 2003-04 and two Sweet Sixteen stops with NC State (2011-12 and 2014-15). His teams also have participated in the NIT on four other occasions.

DAVID PATRICK begins a new era at UC Riverside as a first-time head coach. Patrick had successful assistant coaching stints at TCU and LSU before arriving in the Inland Empire. He is known as an outstanding recruiter, credited with bringing in 2016 No. 1 overall pick Ben Simmons to LSU. He also coached NBA champion and Australian national team guards Patty Mills and Matthew Dellavedova while working as an assistant at Saint Mary's.

THE 2017-18 SEASON IN REVIEW

The Big West had several key moments take place during the 2017-18 season.

- Cal State Fullerton became the eighth different school in eight years to win the Big West Tournament at Honda Center. The list of champions since the tourney moved to Honda Center in 2011 – UC Davis (2017), Hawai'i (2016), UC Irvine (2015), Cal Poly (2014), Pacific (2013), Long Beach State (2012) and UC Santa Barbara (2011).

- CSF won its third Big West Tournament title all-time – and first in 10 years. Other title teams were in 1978 and 2008.

- UC Davis accumulated 20 wins for the third time in four years, and won its second regular season title over that stretch after finishing 12-4 in league play.

- Under first-year head coach Joe Pasternack, UC Santa Barbara set the Big West record for biggest turnaround in one season and he took a program that finished 6-22 in 2016-17, to a 23-9 mark in 2017-18. The +17 win improvement not only was the best in league history, the Gauchos went from setting the school record for losses to tying the program benchmark for wins.

- UC Irvine notched its sixth straight winning season, the longest such streak by a Big West school since UCSB reeled off seven straight from 2005-12.

MEDIA PEGS UC IRVINE AS PRESEASON FAVORITE

For the second straight season, UC Irvine finished as the favorite to win the Big West regular season title in the preseason media poll. The 24-member panel predicted a tightly bunched base with the top four teams splitting first-place votes. UCI topped everyone with 192 points and 10 first-place votes. Cal State Fullerton was second with 183 poll points and four first-place tallies. UC Davis was third with 180 points and six first-place votes, while UC Santa Barbara earned four first-place nods and 149 points for fourth place. Long Beach State (116 points), Hawaii (110), UC Riverside (61), Cal Poly (47) and CSUN (42) followed suit in the poll.

SHORTS II HEADLINES PRESEASON ALL-LEAGUE TEAM

Four returning players off last season's all-conference first team were tabbed by the media to the 2018-19 Big West Preseason All-Conference Team. UC Davis guard **TJ SHORTS II**, the first dual recipient in league history of Player of the Year and Newcomer of the Year honors – led a distinguished list. Cal State Fullerton teammates **KYLE ALLMAN, JR.** and **KHALIL AHMAD** also earned recognition, along with UC Santa Barbara junior **MAX HEIDEGGER**, and UC Irvine teammates **EVAN LEONARD** and **TOMMY RUTHERFORD**. Allman, Jr., Heidegger and Rutherford joined Shorts II on the 2018 All-Big West First Team.

Two Named To Henson Award Watch List

Colleg Insider.com released a 50-player "Watch List" for its annual Lou Henson Award, and the Big West is represented by Cal State Fullerton senior **KYLE ALLMAN, JR.** and UC Davis senior **TJ SHORTS II**. The Lou Henson Award is presented annually to the nation's top mid-major player in Division I college basketball. Allman, Jr., a first team all-conference choice as a junior, is No. 2 in the Big West in scoring (18.5 ppg) through 13 games. Shorts II, the reigning Big West Player of the Year, is No. 7 in scoring (14.2 ppg), tied for No. 6 in assists (3.8 apg) and No. 6 in steals (1.5 spg).

The Big West has now defeated programs from major conferences in 10 consecutive seasons dating back to 2009-10, with a total of 35 victories in that span. The breakdown: 23-Pac 12, 4-Big East, 3-SEC, 2-ACC, 2-Big 10, 1-Big XII.

He now needs to surpass Pat Douglass (197, 1997-2010) for the record. In addition, Turner is now ranked ninth in Big West history with 169 career victories. Turner is on pace to become the third-fastest coach in league history to reach the 200-win mark, with Jerry Tarkanian and Neil McCarthy the only two Turner cannot outdo. The ninth-year coach has led the Anteaters to 20-win campaigns in five of the last six seasons.
