Race for Big West Tournament Position Heating Up

With just two weeks remaining until the end of the regular season, the race for the Big West tournament will reach a frenetic pace as teams jockey for the top four positions.

#8 UC Davis currently has the lead but #13 UC Santa Barbara and Cal Poly are hot on the Aggies' heels for the top spot in the conference. Those two clubs can't look ahead as Cal State Northridge and #20 UC Irvine aim to better their slots and crash the four-team conference postseason derby.

This week's schedule is littered with matches that could start to shape the conference tournament picture.

Wednesday, #13 UC Santa Barbara and Cal State Northridge renew their rivalry with an early afternoon showdown at Matador Soccer Field. Not only will a CSUN win or tie even up the season series, it will put more pressure on #20 UC Irvine to get a result against Cal State Fullerton later in the day. The Matadors are also just two points behind third place Cal Poly which visits UC Riverside looking not only to keep pace with the top two teams, but also put some distance between them and CSUN.

Saturday, the Highlanders face their second straight top four team in the Big West as Cal State Northridge comes to the Inland Empire. UCR will look to reverse an earlier 1-0 road decision against the Matadors as well as put a roadblock into CSUN's potential postseason plans. Later that night, a big match is brewing in Santa Barbara as the Gauchos welcome #20 UC Irvine to town in a game pitting two top 20 teams nationally. Aside from just needing a win for standings purposes, the Anteaters probably want a victory in general as they've tied each of their last three conference matches and four of the six Big West matches they've played to this point. As for UCSB, the UCI match is the second in a tough finishing stretch that has it playing the current fourth, fifth, third and first place teams to finish the regular season.

Wrapping things up on Sunday is another big matchup in Spanos Stadium as #8 UC Davis heads south to play homestanding Cal Poly. The Aggies are looking to sweep the season series from the Mustangs, which could be a big tiebreaker as the conference tournament looms on the horizon. Meanwhile, Cal Poly is aiming to reestablish the dominance they've had in Spanos. The Mustangs are 0-1-1 and have scored just one goal in their last two home matches after starting the season 6-0-0 with an average of 2.5 goals per outing.

BIG WEST MEN'S SOCCER PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Curtis Helps Aggies Stay Atop Big West Standings

UC Davis midfielder **Dylan Curtis** (Pleasanton, Calif./Amador Valley HS) was an instrumental piece in the offensive attack in the Aggies' 1-0-1 week, netting him his second Big West Player of the Week award of the season.

The senior started his week with a goal with the tying goal in the 81st minute against Cal State Northridge, a match the Aggies would eventually win by a 3-2 margin.

He then followed that up with another game-tying goal against UC Irvine, a 50th minute strike that knotted the score at 1-1 in UCD's eventual tie against the Anteaters.

Curtis' two scores give him a career-high five goals on the season, while his 20 points now rank fourth in the conference.

BIG WEST MEN'S SOCCER NEWS AND NOTES

AROUND THE BIG WEST: The third RPI rankings have been released by the NCAA and once again the Big West is proving its worth among the nation's elite. UC Davis is once again the highest ranked school at #12, while UC Santa Barbara's recent places it #14. UC Irvine is keeping its strong bid for the NCAAs alive with the #37 slot, while Cal State Northridge has risen all the way to #43. Cal Poly is next at the #68 position, while UC Riverside (144) and Cal State Fullerton (148) round out the conference.

TEAM-BY-TEAM NOTEBOOKS:

CAL POLY: Cal Poly came up with a pair of ties last week to remain in third place in the Big West standings at 3-2-2 (11 points). The Mustangs first played #20 UC Irvine to a 1-1 draw, then came up with a scoreless tie on the road against Cal State Northridge ... **Eric Branagan-Franco** established a career-best in saves in the match against the Anteaters with 11 stops, the fifth most in a single game in conference history. The 11 saves came match after he posted 10 in the double overtime loss to UC Santa Barbara. Branagan-Franco continued his stellar play against CSUN with five more saves ... **David Zamora** scored his sixth goal of the season against UCI, equaling his goal output from a year ago ... Head coach **Paul Holocher** coached in his 200th career match against the Matadors. He is 136-43-21 in eight plus seasons as a head coach at UC Santa Cruz and Cal Poly.

CAL STATE FULLERTON: Cal State Fullerton went 1-1-0 in two home matches last week, topping UC Riverside by a 3-1 count and falling to #16 UC Santa Barbara, 2-1 ... **Nick Posthuma**, **T.J. Detviler** and **Shay Spitz** each put one in the back of the net against UCR, while **Michael Denny** scored his second goal of the season in the loss to UCSB ... The Titan offense is back on track with eight goals in their past four outings after not scoring in the four matches prior ... The one goal loss to the Gauchos was the eight defeat by one score to UCSB in the past ten outings. Each one of those ten matches has been a defeat at the hands of UC Santa Barbara.

CAL STATE NORTHRIDGE: Cal State Northridge went 0-1-1 in two conference matches last week, falling in tough fashion on the road to league-leading #8 UC Davis, 3-2, and picking up a scoreless draw at home against Cal Poly ... **Camilo Rojas** and **Sunghyun Kim** scored for the Matadors against the Aggies, a match CSUN had a 2-1 lead in the 81st minute but could not hold on for the win ... **Kevin Guppy** picked up eight saves over the two matches, six of them coming in the draw against the Mustangs ... The loss to the Aggies snapped a statistical oddity for CSUN. It marked the first time all season that the club had scored two goals and had not posted a win or tie. The Matadors were 5-0-2 in such matches prior to the UCD game.

UC DAVIS: #8 UC Davis had a 1-0-1 showing in two home matches last week to remain in first place in the Big West with a 4-1-3 record (15 points). The Aggies had a come-from-behind win against Cal State Northridge by a 3-2 final, then tied #20 UC Irvine 1-1 ... The Aggies got two goals from **Quincy Amarikwa** and another from Big West Player of the Week **Dylan Curtis** to get by the Matadors. Curtis and Amarikwa scored five minutes apart in the 81st and 86th minutes, respectively, to deliver the win ... Curtis picked up his second goal of the week in the 50th minute against the Anteaters. The two scores give him a career-best five goals and his first 20-point season as a collegiate player ... **Ryan McCowan** had a notable match against CSUN. He gave up two scores on CSUN's only two shots on goal, but picked up the win thanks to the clutch offense.

UC IRVINE: #20 UC Irvine picked up two more ties in two Big West road matches last week, giving it four in six conference games. The Anteaters posted draws against Cal Poly and #8 UC Davis by 1-1 scores ... **Matt Murphy** picked up a goal against the Mustangs on a penalty kick and recorded an assist against the Aggies. He finished the week with 76 career points, making him UCI's all-time leader and ranking him in a tie for sixth all-time in Big West history. He also ranks seventh in league history in goals with 30 ... **Andrew Fontein** recorded eight saves on the week, five of them coming against one of the top offenses in the country in UC Davis ... The two ties give the Anteaters 11 dating back to the start of last season, they had only posted six draws in 2005-06.

UC RIVERSIDE: UC Riverside fell in its two matches last week, dropping a 3-1 decision to Cal State Fullerton on the road and a 2-1 non-conference home match against Cal State Bakersfield ... Joel Crompton scored both goals for the Highlanders, giving him a career-best six on the season. He had tallied six career goals coming into the season ... Ryan Schmitz ranks second in the conference in saves (62) and is fourth in saves per game (3.88), while Crompton moved up to a tie for fourth in goals and sixth in points (13).

UC SANTA BARBARA: #13 UC Santa Barbara won its only match of the week, a hard fought 2-1 win over Cal State Fullerton. The victory was the 10th straight win over the Titans in the series ... **Chris Pontius** scored his career-high 12th goal, while **Nick Perera** netted the game-winner in the 74th minute. Perera has put a goal on the board four times in the clubs' last six outings, leading UCSB to a 4-1-1 record in that stretch ... Pontius is the first UCSB player to tally double-digit goals in back-to-back seasons since Drew McAthly posted three consecutive 10+ goal seasons from 2002-04.
