NCAA Tournament Play on Tap For Three

The drama of the NCAA Tournament begins this weekend for three Big West schools as Cal Poly, Cal State Fullerton and Long Beach State commence the chase for the national championship with 61 other competitors.

Cal Poly was placed in the Stanford Regional along with Nevada, Portland State and the host #8 seeded Cardinal. The Mustangs will play the Wolfpack first, a squad they defeated 1-0 on March 1. Cal Poly also has taken on Stanford twice this season, dropping a pair of one-run contests, 3-2 and 2-1 (10), on February 28 and March 3, respectively. This is the Mustangs' second foray into the NCAA Tournament in DI program history and they will be seeking their first postseason victory since moving up to the highest level of intercollegiate softball.

Cal State Fullerton is no stranger to the postseason, having been to the NCAA Regionals on 24 prior occasions. The Titans are placed in arguably one of the tougher regionals with opening opponent LSU, San Diego State and defending national champion #10 seed Arizona State. CSF has played only SDSU previously this season, dropping a pair of contests, but have the most games played against the NCAA field of the Big West playoff teams with 20. Cal State Fullerton also owns conference records with 39 postseason victories and 79 total NCAA games.

Long Beach State is making its second appearance in the NCAAs in three seasons under Kim Sowder. The 49ers will make a quick trip north to a familiar site as the selection committee slotted them in the Los Angeles Regional, the sixth time that LBSU is making the short trip to the north. The regional has LBSU taking on #2 seed UCLA, while Fresno State and UNLV match up in the other opening round game. The 49ers have had success this season against the three other teams gathered in the regional, topping both UCLA and Fresno State, while falling to UNLV by two runs on a neutral field.

CSF's Anderson Leads Offense in Sweep over UCSB

Cal State Fullerton outfielder **Torrie Anderson** (Castaic, Calif./Valencia HS) took home her second Big West Player of the Week award of 2009 after leading the Titan offense against UC Santa Barbara.

The sophomore kicked off the three-game set with a 1-for-3 effort in the opener, but the one hit was a two-run blast that put her team ahead to stay in the 4-2 win.

Game two was even more kind to Anderson as she went 3-for-4 with a walk and a double. Her first inning double set the stage for the first run in an eventual 2-1, nine-inning Titan win. Anderson also had it going in the finale, going 2-for-4 with two RBI and a run scored. Her RBI single in the fourth gave CSF a 2-0 lead, while her RBI double during the six-run Titan sixth helped give the club all the offense it would need in a 6-5 win.

For the series, Anderson batted .545 (6-11) with a homer, four RBI, three runs scored, two doubles and two walks. She also tallied a .615 on base percentage and did not commit an error in the field.

BIG WEST PITCHER OF THE WEEK

LBSU's Petty Powers Club Past Pacific

Long Beach State's **Taylor Petty** (San Pedro, Calif./San Pedro HS) finished up her first regular season with an outstanding series against Pacific, netting her Big West Pitcher of the Week accolades.

The freshman's first start of the series in game two was a masterpiece, going all eight innings of LBSU's 2-1 win. She allowed three hits, one run (earned), walked two and struck out 11 in the key win.

Petty was then given the ball for the finale and she responded with another complete game, one-run win in the 49ers' 6-1 victory. This time around she allowed five hits to go along with that one earned run, walked three and struck out seven.

For the series, Petty posted a 0.93 ERA in her 15.0 innings of work. She allowed just eight hits, two runs, five walks and struck out 18. She also allowed just a .150 batting average and tied her career-high with 11 K's in the game two win.

Three Softball Clubs Gain Inclusion to 2009 NCAA Tournament

The Big West extended its multi-bid streak to 25 in softball as three teams nabbed bids to the NCAA Tournament. Cal Poly, Cal State Fullerton and Long Beach State will join 61 others in the chase for the national championship beginning this weekend.

The 64-team field is broken up into 16 regionals with four teams at each site. Using a double-elimination format, the advancing teams will be slotted in eight sites for the Super Regional round where they will play a best-of-three series. From there, the eight remaining clubs head to Oklahoma City for the Women's College World Series beginning May 28. The WCWS is double-elimination until the final two teams standing play a best-of-three series to decide the national champion.

Cal Poly (39-10, 18-3 Big West) claimed the Big West automatic bid into the NCAA Tournament after winning the conference title for the second time in three years. The Mustangs were placed in the Stanford Regional along with Nevada (39-17, 15-5 WAC), Portland State (29-24, 15-5 PCSC) and the host #8 national seed Cardinal (44-9, 16-5 Pac-10). The schedule calls for Cal Poly to play the Wolfpack Friday, with the Vikings and Cardinal to follow. The Mustangs are an excellent offensive bunch, hitting .304 with 234 runs scored, 31 homers and 208 RBI. Senior Melissa Pura is one of the top offensive threats for Cal Poly, hitting .379 with seven homers, 31 RBI, nine doubles and 32 runs scored, while junior Krysten Cary has had a breakout season with a .273 batting average, 14 homers, 38 RBI and 30 runs scored. In the circle, The Mustangs are led by sophomore Anna Cahn in the circle as she has gone an incredible 27-5 with a 1.171 ERA in 232.2 innings. She has also struck out 101, posted 27 complete games, three shutouts, two saves and walked just 31. Junior Helen Pena has also been reliable in 2009 with an 11-5 record, 1.49 ERA, four shutouts and 74 strikeouts in 103.1 innings.

Cal State Fullerton (29-19, 17-4 Big West) garnered at-large status into the NCAA Tournament, its 10th appearance in the past 11 seasons and the 27th showing in the postseason in program history. One of the hotter teams in the country with 24 wins in their last 31 games, the Titans were slotted in the Tempe Regional along with LSU (32-16-1, 15-10-1 SEC), San Diego State (33-18, 10-5 Mountain West) and host #10 national seed Arizona State (40-16, 10-11 Pac-10). CSF will battle the Tigers Friday in the first game, with the Aztec/Sun Devils game to follow. The first two games in the regional will be televised live on ESPNU. While the young Titans have batted only .245 as a team, they have produced clutch offensive moments over the last month and a half. Senior Courtney Martinez is the club's leading hitter at .323 to go along with seven doubles and 20 runs scored, while juco transfer Francesca Gonzales has been spectacular with a .315 batting average, 10 homers and 24 RBI. Sophomore Torrie Anderson has also been a solid offensive performer to the tune of a .279 average, 10 home runs and a team-leading 34 RBI. Sophomore Ari Cervantes has been Cal State Fullerton's top performer in the circle, going 19-10 with a 2.15 ERA in 208.2 innings. She has also picked up three saves, 26 complete games, shut out five opponents and struck out 117 batters. Redshirt freshman Krystal Heinle has been impressive in her first season of competition, going 10-7 with a 2.75 ERA, one shutout, 12 complete games and 91 strikeouts in 119.2 innings.

Long Beach State (34-19, 15-6 Big West), the 2008 Big West champion, is in the postseason for the second time in three seasons under Kim Sowder. LBSU gained at-large status into the postseason and was placed in the Los Angeles Regional along with Fresno State (36-18, 15-5 WAC), UNLV (31-19, 7-8 Mountain West) and #2 national seed and host UCLA (41-9, 16-5 Pac-10). The 49ers will open the tournament against the Bruins Friday, with the Bulldogs and Runnin' Rebels to battle in prior to that game. Long Beach State is lead offensively by senior Jennifer Griffin who is batting .329 with eight homers and 40 RBI, while classmate Danielle Linke leads the team in hitting at .353 to go along with seven homers, 26 RBI, 60 hits, 13 doubles and two triples. The 49ers have a two-headed monster in the circle with sophomore Brooke Turner and freshman Taylor Petty. Turner has turned in another stellar season with a 17-11 record, 2.34 ERA, 145 strikeouts, 21 complete games and six shutouts over 170.2 innings. Petty has been a revelation in her first collegiate season, going 15-4 with a 1.41 ERA in 144.1 innings. She has also posted four shutouts, 15 complete games and has struck out 129 hitters.

BIG WEST NOTES

SOME POSTSEASON TIDBITS

Big West regular season champion Cal Poly is making the second NCAA Tournament appearance in its Division I history and second in three years under Jenny Condon. The Mustangs went 0-2 at the Provo Regional in their last NCAA appearance in 2007. Cal State Fullerton is making its 10th NCAA appearance in the last 11 seasons, 21st as a member of the Big West and 26th postseason appearance in program history. The Titans' 25 NCAA Regional appearances is the third-most in the history of the NCAA and the club is the lone school to advance to the Super Regional round in conference history. A year ago, CSF was placed in the Los Angeles Regional and lost two tightly contested outings. Long Beach State is back for its 19th appearance in the NCAA Regionals, tied for ninth-most all-time in NCAA history. LBSU's 2008 postseason began as the #14 seed nationally, but the 49ers were unable to advance out of the Des Moines Regional, going 1-2 against that field.

CAL POLY CONTINUES ODD YEAR RUN

Cal Poly has mastered the art of success....every odd year under Jenny Condon. In Condon's first season in 2005, the Mustangs won 35 games and finished second in the Big West with a 15-6 record. In 2007, Cal Poly won its first Big West title with a record of 14-4 in conference play and amassed a single-season Division I record 39 wins. 2009 rolls around and the Mustangs are Big West champions once again, win 18 out of 21 games against league foes, tie the single-season DI wins record with 39 and claim their second trip to the NCAA Tournament. In all those odd years, Cal Poly is 113-43 overall, 47-13 in Big West games and won two league titles. In the even years under Condon, the Mustangs are 51-45 overall, 23-16 in Big West games and have not won the league crown.

2009...THE YEAR OF COACHING MILESTONES

It was the year of the coach on the Big West calendar as several managers reached significant milestones during the course of the 2009 season. Cal State Fullerton head coach Michelle Gromacki entered an elite group of coaches in Big West history with her 150th conference win, making her just the fifth manager in the 24-year plus history of Big West softball to record at least 350 career wins and 150 conference wins at a league school. The other members of the select club are former Long Beach State skipper Pete Manarino (791, 393), former Titan great Judi Garman (581, 302), current Pacific head coach Brian Kolze (519, 210) and Shan McDonald (350, 190) of former league member UNLV. Cal State Northridge head coach Barbara Jordan also joined select company with her 200th career win. Jordan became the 10th coach in Big West history to win 200 games at a member school and stands just 25 victories shy of moving into ninth place on the all-time victories list. Connie Miner of UC Riverside surpassed the 100-victory plateau as head coach of UCR, the first coach in program history to achieve that feat in the club's DI history. Finally Long Beach State head coach Kim Sowder gained her 100th victory in just her third season at the helm of the 49er program, performing close to a level that her predecessor, Pete Manarino, achieved in his first three seasons (119).

TIPPING TOWARD THE TOP HALF

The Big West has seen its share of parity over the past few seasons, but 2009 saw the trio atop the league perform at a level unseen in many a year. For the first time since 2001, the top three teams in the league won 15 or more conference games and 29 or more contests overall. That 2001 season also saw three Big West team represented in the NCAA Tournament.

ROAD TRIP...BUT WE'RE NOT GOING VERY FAR!

As the only conference in America to have all its member schools in one state, the Big West added a scheduling oddity that probably won't be replicated anytime soon. Conference champion Cal Poly is the lone softball team in the NCAA to have played all its games in one state. The last time the Mustangs played a game out of the state was February 15-17, 2008 at the Louisville Slugger Desert Classic in Las Vegas, Nev. If Cal Poly reaches the Super Regional round, it will break the 85-game, California-only streak.

BIG WEST TEAM NOTES

Cal Poly MUSTANGS

• Cal Poly won its sixth-straight Big West series last weekend, a road sweep over UC Riverside. The three-game victory netted the Mustangs their second Big West title in three seasons. Cal Poly won the games by 8-2, 4-0 and 11-1 (6) finals ... **Anna Cahn** was outstanding as both a batter and pitcher in the series, batting .375 (3-8) with two homers and nine RBI, while going 2-0 with a 1.08 ERA in 14.0 innings in the circle. She produced a career-high RBI in the series finale, a game Cal Poly needed to clinch the Big West title outright ... The Mustangs have now won 39 games heading into the NCAA Tournament, tying the program's DI best that was achieved previously in the Mustangs' 2007 Big West championship season. Their 18 conference wins is also the most the squad has won as a member of the Big West.

Cal State Fullerton TITANS

• Cal State Fullerton's sweep of UC Santa Barbara last weekend gave the squad a 29-19 overall record and 17-4 mark in Big West games. The series was shifted to Bob Janssen Field in San Luis Obispo due to the destructive fire in the Santa Barbara area. CSF won the tight series by 4-2, 2-1 (9) and 6-5 finals ... **Torrie Anderson** batted .545 (6-11) with a homer and four RBI on her way to Big West Player of the Week accolades, while **Krystal Heinle** collected a 1-0 record, 0.81 ERA and collected a save in 8.2 innings to lead the Titans in the circle ... Cal State Fullerton was extended an at-large invite to the NCAA Tournament, its 10th postseason appearance in the last 11 seasons and 21st NCAA appearance as a member of the Big West.

Cal State Northridge MATADORS

• Cal State Northridge finished up the 2009 season on a strong note with a series win on the road over UC Davis.
