• Larry Lee enters his eighth season as the Cal Poly Mustangs' skipper. In seven seasons with the Mustangs, Lee has produced 14 first-team All-Big West players and four All-Americans.

- In 2009, Lee guided the Mustangs to a 37-21 overall mark and a 14-10 Big West record, good enough for third in the league. Cal Poly went on to compete in its first NCAA regional playoff since moving to Division I prior to the 1995 season.
- Lee came to the Mustangs program on July 22, 2002, after 16 seasons as head coach at Cuesta College, where he led the Cougars to four trips to the California Community College State Final Four (1992, 1997, 2001, 2002). Lee pushed Cuesta to the Southern California Regionals in his last six years with the program to lift his total to 11.
- Before becoming head coach at Cuesta College in 1987, Lee served as an assistant coach for the Cougars for two seasons and at Cal Poly for one. Lee earned a bachelor's degree in physical education/kinesiology from Pepperdine in 1983 and a master's degree in physical education from Cal Poly in 1985 as well as an adaptive physical education credential from Cal Poly in 1988.

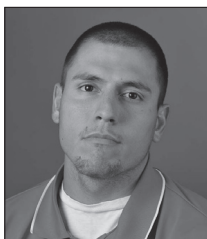

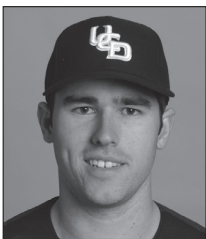
