Streaking Big West Tennis Teams Meet This Week With Conference Titles Up For Grab

After a four-month battle through the regular season, the right to be named best in the Big West comes down to this – the Big West Tennis Championships. Conference rivals will square off at the Indian Wells Tennis Garden in Indian Wells, Calif. on April 21-24, with the men's and women's winners gaining an automatic berth into the NCAA Championships. Winning the Big West title will not be an easy feat for any team, as many intriguing and challenging matchups stand in the way to claiming the conference crown.

The Big West women's tennis championship starts action off on Thursday with No. 8 seed Cal State Fullerton (6-14, 0-7 Big West) facing No. 9 Utah State (11-11, 0-1). Both squads enter the match winners of two of their last three, with the winner advancing to take on No. 1 seed Pacific in the quarterfinals on Friday. The Tigers, ranked No. 68 in the nation, come into championship competition with the conference's best record at 17-5, and a perfect 6-0 in Big West action. The Tigers have rolled to five wins in their last six outings, led by sophomore **Vana Mrazovic**, ranked No. 110 in the nation in singles play.

The second first-round matchup on the women's side features No. 7 UC Riverside and No. 10 Idaho on Thursday. The Highlanders (8-11, 2-7) enter the tournament winners of two of their last three, and face Idaho for the first time this season. Idaho (6-6, 0-0) enters the match with two straight wins, both of which were shutouts over Eastern Washington and Gonzaga.

The winner between the Highlanders and the Vandals faces No. 2 UC Santa Barbara (14-7, 5-2) in the quarterfinals on Friday. The Gauchos, ranked No. 65 in the nation, will enter that matchup winners of five of their last six, including wins over four consecutive conference opponents. UC Santa Barbara also features junior **Marielle Gruenig**, the No. 1 singles player for the Gauchos who has won 16 of her last 17 singles matches.

In the first of quarterfinal action on Friday, No. 4 Cal Poly (8-11, 4-3) takes on No. 5 UC Irvine (12-9, 4-2). The Mustangs enter the match looking to break a late season skid, but earned a 6-1 victory at UC Irvine on Feb. 27 in the only match between the teams this season. UCI has won five of its last six matches, led by the nation's No. 123 singles player, senior **Anna Bentzer**.

The final quarterfinal matchup on Friday is between No. 3 Long Beach State (12-10, 5-2) and No. 6 Cal State Northridge (8-13, 2-5). The No. 60-ranked 49ers are fresh off last week's 7-0 victory over Cal State Fullerton, and defeated the Matadors earlier this season at home on Feb. 5. The 49ers feature a tough out in freshman **Stephanie Bengson**, who has won 11 of her last 12 matches at the No. 2 spot.

In the Big West men's tennis championship, No. 2 Pacific (11-8, 3-1) and No. 7 Idaho (5-13, 0-1) will be the first to swing rackets in the quarterfinals on Friday. Pacific rolls into the matchup riding a three-match win streak, led by junior **Arnar Sigurdsson**, ranked No. 83 in the nation in singles play. Sigurdsson, a six-time Big West Athlete of the Week this season, has defeated 18 of his last 19 opponents in singles competition at the No. 1 spot for the Tigers. Idaho also has to contend with Tiger junior **Jorgen Vestli**, ranked No. 105 in the nation, who is 14-3 on the season at the No. 2 spot.

The second quarterfinal matchup on the men's side features No. 4 Cal Poly (14-11, 2-3) and No. 5 UC Riverside (6-15, 0-4). The Mustangs enter the tournament as the Big West's hottest team. Cal Poly is riding a season-best nine-match win streak, the longest winning streak in the conference this season. Cal Poly is led by junior **Brett Van Linge**, a winner of 12 of his last 13 matches at the No. 4 spot.

Although the Mustangs have not lost since March 24, UC Riverside poses a challenging matchup nonetheless. These two teams faced each other on April 17, with Cal Poly squeaking out a close 4-3 victory at home over the Highlanders. The winner of that match faces No. 1 UC Irvine (12-8, 3-1) in the semifinals on Saturday. The Anteaters are winners of eight of their last 10 matches and are led by senior **Brian Morton**, ranked No. 119 in the nation in singles action.

The final quarterfinal matchup in the men's bracket is between No. 3 UC Santa Barbara (9-12, 3-1) and No. 6 Utah State (10-11, 1-1). The Gauchos were ranked No. 75 in the nation last week and meets a Utah State squad that is entering the event on a five-match winning streak.

Long Beach State tries to defend its 2004 Big West title on the women's side, as the 49ers have won two of the last three conference crowns (2002). UC Santa Barbara enters the championship with the most Big West titles on the women's side with six. The Gauchos won all six of their championships in a row from 1991-97.

On the men's side, Pacific looks to defend its 2004 Big West crown, replacing UC Santa Barbara after the Gauchos won back-to-back Big West titles in 2002 and 2003. UC Irvine enters the men's championship with the most Big West titles in conference history at 11, but the Anteaters have not won one since 1993.

The Big West championship matches will take place on Sunday, April 24, with the men hitting the court at 9 a.m., and the women at noon.

This is also the first year that Albertsons Grocery Stores is sponsoring the participants hospitality for the Big West Men's and Women's Tennis Championships.
